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Dust Control/CaCl₂ Brine CCRC Bid No. 19-06

The Cheboygan County Road Commission will accept sealed bids for supplies pertaining to Mineral Brine and Liquid CaCl₂ Materials. All Work and Materials shall meet current ***MDOT Standards Specifications for Construction, 2012***. Successful bidder shall provide lab analysis of materials and Safety Data Sheets and Certifications that all materials meet State and/or Federal requirements for intended use. **NO FRACKING MATERIAL ALLOWED.**

The 2016 dust control program for the Road Commission Primary road system is estimated at 42,000 gallons. Applied material will be placed at the direction of CCRC personal. This does not include Township road brine. Any brine ordered for Townships will be placed at the direction of the specific Townships. The estimated volume of material for the 2018-2019 winter season is 20,000 to 40,000 gallons of mineral brine with minimum of 26% concentration. The CCRC reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity based on its need at the time of order.

Bidder shall provide proof of insurance including but not limited to: public liability and property damage, workers compensation, unemployment and other coverage as might be required by law. Bidder shall provide indemnifications for the Cheboygan County Road Commission for any and all claims arising as a result of operations in the performance of the above services.

Bids shall be submitted on the enclosed CCRC Dust Control/Brine Bid Sheet in a sealed envelope clearly indentifying the bidder and marked "Dust Control/Brine".

Bidders shall include written statement of allowable discounts and terms of payment. Bid prices shall be valid for a period of one year from date of award.

Bids are due at **9:00 a.m., Tuesday, February 19, 2019**, at which time, the bid will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bid results will not be available until they have been tabulated and presented with recommendations and approved by the Road Commission Board at their next regular meeting on February 21, 2019.
