**STATEMENT OF VOTES – CERTIFICATE OF DETERMINATION,
GENERAL ELECTION - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2015**

MACKINAW CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy its maximum authorized millage rate of 17.7634 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2015 tax levy. The remaining 2.5 mills is only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 20.2634 mills (\$20.2634 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Mackinaw City Public Schools, Cheboygan and Emmet Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2016 to 2020, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 17.7634 mills are levied in 2016 is approximately \$1,887,121 (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2015 tax levy)?
