

Note the difference in 2013 and 2014 residential revenue is due to taxable rates increasing from \$20. to \$24.

Our processing cost was **\$111,229** and **\$110,537** for 2013 and 2014, respectively.

In 2014 we purchased two more bins. We use them for additional bins at some of the existing sites through the summer during the busiest times and also we use them to exchange with full bins at the sites, this saves in transportation cost and also leaves an empty bin so people do not have to wait for the bins to return.

The table below shows our transportation cost for the past four years. The transportation cost for 2012, 2013 and 2014 is based on truck maintenance/repair, fuel, driver cost, truck depreciation and cost to have Republic haul while truck is in for repair.

If we had not purchased the truck in 2011 to haul our own bins, our estimated cost for transportation in 2014 would have been \$132,492. By hauling our own bins in 2014, we saved approximately \$64,037.

In 2012 and 2013, Emmet County began taking mixed recyclables. This means we no longer have to separate glass tin and plastic containers in the same bin; they can all be combined together allowing the bin to fill more evenly. This saves in trucking cost by being able to haul full bins.

2015 MILLAGE RATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Cheboygan County has the authority to levy its own maximum allowable millage rate of 7.4592 mills distributed as follows: 5.6592 mills for General County Operations, .5000 mills for Senior Citizens Operations, .3000 mills for Ambulance Authority Operations and 1.0000 mills for Roads; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that to maintain basic county services, it will be necessary to levy the rate of 7.4092 mills; and,

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was given, and a public hearing was held as the County Budget Hearing;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Cheboygan shall levy the millage of 7.4092 for 2015.

Motion by Commissioner _____ seconded by Commissioner _____, to adopt the 2015 County Millage Rate Resolution authorizing the levy of the rate of 7.4092 mills distributed as follows: 5.6592 mills for General County Operations, .5000 mills for Senior Citizens Operations, .2500 mills for Ambulance Authority Operations and 1.0000 mills for Roads and authorize Chairperson to sign. TAX RESOLUTION
