

Marriage License Requirements
During Covid-19
Cheboygan County, MI

- At least one applicant must be a resident of Cheboygan County, MI.
- IF both parties are Out of State residents, you must apply with the county the marriage will take place.
- There is a three day waiting period from the time of application to the date that you may pick up the license.
- The license is only good for **30 days**.
- If the County Building is closed to the public due to the Covid-19 pandemic-both parties must sign the Affidavit for License to Marry (aka Application for Marriage License) in front of a notary. If you both go the drive-thru of your bank at the same time and present the Affidavit for License to Marry and both of your IDs; a notary should be able to notarize the document for you.
- Both applicants' social security numbers must be on the Affidavit for License to Marry.
- You will need to send a copy of both applicants' IDs, the Affidavit for License to Marry and a check/money order made payable to Cheboygan County Clerk, PO Box 70, Cheboygan, MI 49721.
- \$20 fee for Michigan residents.
- \$30 fee for out of state residents.
- An additional fee of \$10.00 will be added to the cost if you are applying for the Waiver of the Three Day waiting period.
- Please supply a phone number AND email address with your application.

Upon receipt of the Affidavit for License to Marry aka Application for Marriage License, we will prepare the Marriage License and will then email it to you for approval. After you have approved the final Marriage License, we will send you the License in the mail.

If you have any questions or do not have enough time to apply via the U.S. mail, please call our office at 231-627-8808 to make an appointment for application. Both parties would need to be present for this appointment. All precautions will be taken for your safety and the safety of our staff during the Covid-19 Pandemic.
