

NOTICE OF PROJECT PLANNING PUBLIC MEETING

The City of Boyne City will hold a public meeting on the proposed **Sanitary Sewer System and Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements** project for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

The meeting will be held in person at **12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 25, 2023** at the following location: **City Hall, Boyne City, 319 N. Lake Street, Boyne City, MI 49712**

The purpose of the proposed project is to complete wastewater treatment plant upgrades and sanitary sewer collection system improvements to provide performance to meet present day regulatory standards, to replace deteriorated wastewater assets, and minimize long term operation costs.

Project construction will involve the following areas:

Impacts of the proposed project include **short term construction related impacts and financial impacts to the City's wastewater system users. No significant long term adverse impacts are anticipated on either cultural or environmentally sensitive resources.**

The estimated cost to users for the proposed project will be **approximately \$12.8 million total project costs with individual user costs dependent on the level and type of project financing that can be secured by the City for the project. The City intends to pursue project financing with the goal of minimizing impact to the system users.**
