

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MACKINAC ISLAND CITY COUNCIL, HELD IN
THE COURTHOUSE BUILDING, 2ND FLOOR, 7374 MARKET STREET, MACKINAC ISLAND,
MICHIGAN, ON FRIDAY, JULY 7, 2017, AT 4:30 PM**

Commemoration of Borough of Michilimackinac Bicentennial (2017)

Soldiers from Fort Mackinac in 1817 style uniforms performed the Presentation of the Colors.

Mayor Doud thanked local historian, Brian Dunnigan, for bringing the bicentennial to the City's attention, and also spoke on the Bicentennial Commemoration before presenting the commemoration plaque to the council and audience.

County of Mackinac Chairman James Hill and Commissioner Calvin McPhee read and presented the city with a proclamation plaque commemorating the Bicentennial Commemoration.

Brian Dunnigan, Associate Director and Curator of the William L. Clements Library of the University of Michigan, spoke on the beginnings of the Borough of Michilimackinac and how it moved on to become the City of Mackinac Island.

Phil Porter, Director of Mackinac State Historic Parks, spoke on behalf of the Mackinac Island State Park Commission. He thanked the Mayor and City Council for taking such good care of going on under their jurisdiction, and went on to read a resolution that will be presented to the city.

-Mr. Porter spoke also on how important it was for the Mackinac Island State Park and the City of Mackinac Island to continue working together for the greater good of Mackinac Island and its important history.

Mayor Doud went on to read the resolution presented by the Mackinac Island City Council.


