** E-Bikes

The use of E-Bikes is prohibited on Mackinac Island by local ordinance unless the E-Bike meets the requirements of the ordinance and the device is being used because of the user's qualified mobility disability as outlined in City of Mackinac Island Code of Ordinances. If you have a Qualified Mobility Disability, and you are using an E-Bike because of that disability, please provide credible assurance of the disability along with this application. This may consist of a copy of a handicap parking permit, a note from a physician, or other means of credible assurance.

Only Class-1 E-bikes may be used on Mackinac Island and only by persons with qualified mobility disabilities. Class-2 E-bikes may be converted to Class-1 status by removing the throttle.

E-bikes must be visually inspected at the Mackinac Island Police Department before a permit will be issued. Hours for this service are M-F, 9:00am-12:00pm and 1:00pm-3:30pm
