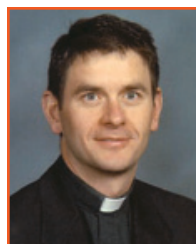

Bishop Earl Boyea

The first of ten children, Bishop Earl Boyea, attended Sacred Heart Seminary High School and College, 1965-1973; the North American College and the Gregorian University in Rome, 1973-1977, 1979-80. Ordained

a priest on May 20, 1978. Named a prelate of honor to His Holiness, Jan. 18, 2000, named auxiliary bishop of Detroit and titular bishop of Siccenna, July 22, 2002, and ordained a bishop on Sept. 13, 2002. Appointed and currently serving as the fifth bishop of Lansing.



Fr. Stan Fortuna

Father Stan Fortuna is one of the eight original members of the Community of Franciscan Friars of the Renewal and a Roman Catholic priest. He has been involved with community development and the implementation of various social

programs in his neighborhood of the South Bronx for over two decades when the religious order was established by John Cardinal O'Connor in 1987. That same year, Fr. Stan founded his non-profit company, Francesco Productions mixing music and message with proceeds going to help poor and impoverished families in the area.



Danny Abramowicz

Currently, Danny is active serving on the Board of Directors of EWTN, *Crossing the Goal* and the Donum Dei Foundation. Also, he serves in an advisory capacity to the Board of Directors of National
