

Bay View's John M. Hall Auditorium Renovation

In the fall of 2010, Bay View Association received a \$3,500 grant from the Community Foundation's Community Endowment toward the capital campaign to fund improvements to the interior of the John M. Hall Auditorium. The space is nearly 100 years old but continues to serve as the central program structure in Bay View. Identified needs included sound and acoustics, lighting, safety and amenities.

Early in the summer of 2011, the first (and most intensive) phase of the renovation was completed, just in time for the beginning of a season of performances in June. With new seating, window shades, light and sound equipment, a hearing loop feature for those with hearing aids, and more, the Hall Auditorium can continue to serve our community for many years to come!
