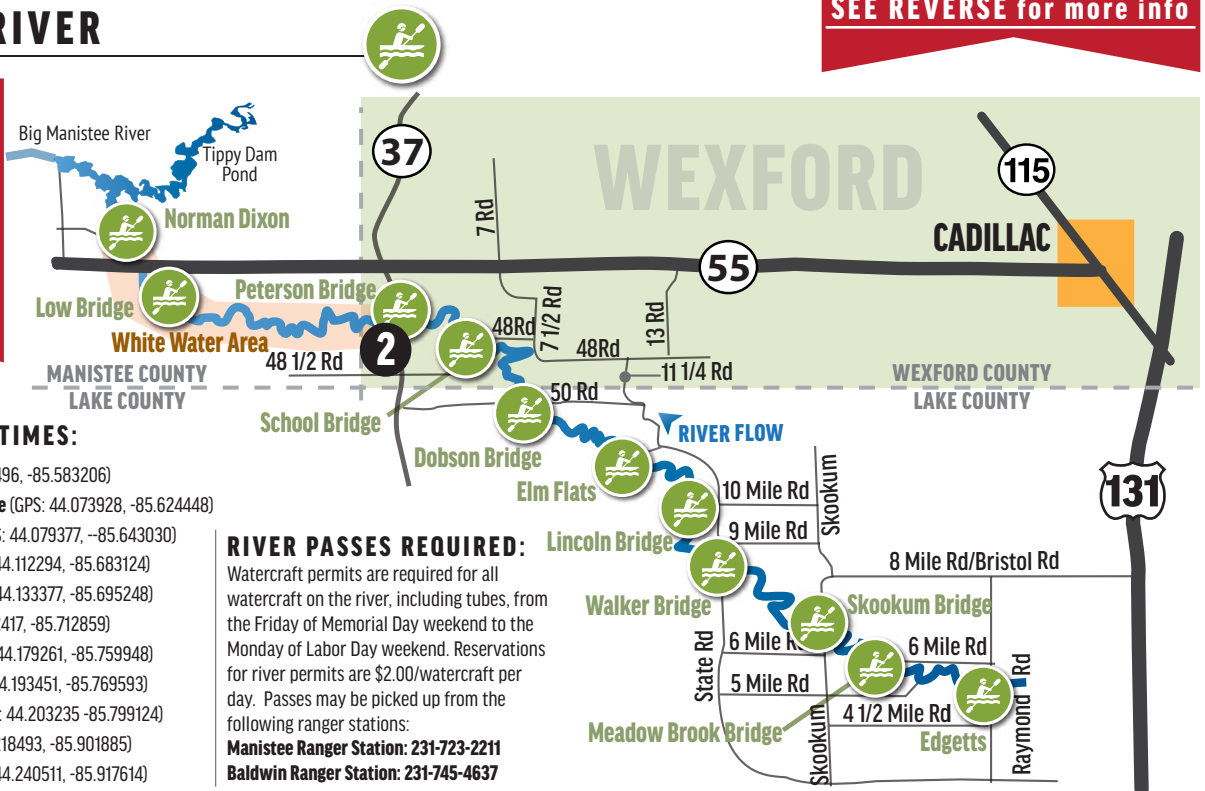

Watercraft permits are required for all watercraft on the river, including tubes, from the Friday of Memorial Day weekend to the Monday of Labor Day weekend. Reservations for river permits are \$2.00/watercraft per day. Passes may be picked up from the following ranger stations:

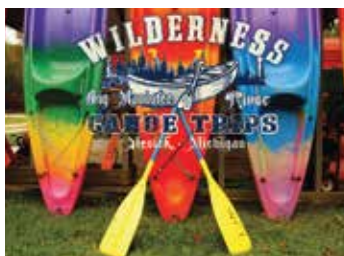

## GENERAL ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION ON YOUR RIVER TRIP:

- Most of our liveries are fully open Memorial Day to Labor Day, please call for times/ reservations ahead earlier in spring and later in fall. Both Early Spring and Fall offer excellent river experiences.
- Please follow all leash laws and clean up after your pet. Pets are not allowed in tubes or rafts.
- All liveries offer round trip shuttles, parking is available at check-in.
- For a safe trip with young children, please be aware that all children in water vessels should be able to swim on own or with Life vest. Rivers are different from lakes due to shoreline debris. Children in carriers are not recommended due to potential unsafe conditions of nature.
