

Company History

In the early 1950's Walter Wojan set out to prove to a skeptical U.S. window industry that well-made aluminum windows and doors could be energy efficient, durable, maintenance-free and economical.

Mr. Wojan's company first introduced his line of extruded aluminum storm windows and doors in 1953, and the product line has since continued to grow. The privately-held firm remains headquartered in Charlevoix [*SHAR-la-voy*] Michigan.

Double-glazed prime windows and doors were brought to market in 1958. And in the early '60's, Wojan Window & Door Corp. became a true pioneer in the design and production of energy efficient windows by utilizing double-sash construction and a unique thermal barrier.

Well-positioned for the energy crisis of the '70's, Wojan's M-35 triple-glazed windows demonstrated the insulating value of airspace at helping stop the transference of heat or cold between the interior and exterior environments. The M-35's attributes continue to be of beneficial appeal for those applications requiring greater acoustical performance and energy efficiency.

Wojan's M-85 Series windows were introduced in 1982. Configured as a horizontal slider, single-hung, or fixed type, they provide a cost-effective choice for new construction or renovation in a wide variety of commercial applications such as multi-family housing, hotels, offices, clinics and classrooms.

In 1999 Wojan began offering its 4500/4600 Series of projected windows. Configured as a hopper, awning, casement or fixed type, they've proved to be a cost-effective alternative for a variety of applications that require heavy commercial or architectural performance ratings.

In 2010 Wojan introduced its versatile, high-performance M-950 Series in single-hung, slider and fixed configurations, followed quickly by the debut of the M-950B Series of Blast-Resistant windows. Ideal for military and government facilities with AT/FP requirements, the M-950B is designed for quick installation by only requiring interior application of blast trim on two sides of the window.

In 2011 Wojan debuted its 2500 and 2600 Series of Sliding Glass Doors – engineered and manufactured in house. With AAMA ratings of up to a CW55, this series offers a variety of sill depths and water ratings, and fits easily with the 2700 Series fixed transom or side lite.

In 2015 Wojan entered a new market by releasing its M1500 and 1600H double-hung tilt-in models. Each feature 3 1/4" frames, 7/8" IGUs and carry a choice of a CW30 or C50 rating. The main difference is that the 1600H has a 3 5/8" bottom rail for a more historic look.

Also in 2015, several of Wojan's models were approved for use in Florida by the Florida Building Commission, and Wojan expanded its sales presence in the state.

In 2016, Wojan first shipped the newly developed 1600H Double-Hung Historic Window as part of the massive renovation of the historic Rosenwald Courts Apartments in Chicago. The window gained approval from the National Park Service which set us on our way to manufacturing over 2,300 units for the project.

Today, two plants manufacture Wojan windows and doors – a 70,000 square foot facility in Charlevoix which also contains an AAMA Certified product performance test bay; and a 90,000 square foot facility in Coldwater, Michigan – strategically located between Detroit and Chicago.

The family-owned corporation has been led by Walter Wojan’s son Dennis since 1970 and has since expanded to a 3rd generation. A graduate of the Farmer School of Business at Miami University, Dennis’ son Michael is the company’s VP of Business Operations, and leads the estimating team on a day-to-day basis.

Honors and Memberships

In 2007 the company was first honored by the awards committee of Inc. magazine, which celebrates the fastest-growing private companies in America. Wojan Window & Door received 4 consecutive *Inc. 5000* awards, indicative of a business plan intent on constant expansion. The ranking reflects Wojan employees’ ongoing efforts toward continuous improvement in areas such as product development, sales support, customer service, supply chain and manufacturing quality.

In 2011 Wojan’s M-950 Series won the USGlass® Magazine Readers’ Choice award for most significant commercial door or window product of 2010.

In 2017 Wojan’s 1600H Series Double-Hung Historic Window was recognized as a Notable Entry for Window & Door™ Magazine’s Crystal Achievement Awards.
